Update: COVID Quarantine and Isolation from DOH-

EFFECTIVE January 11, 2022

“Fully Vaccinated” = Two weeks after the receipt of either two doses of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine or one dose of Johnson and Johnson vaccine or full course of any other recognized vaccine (*NYSDOH memo issued January 10, 2022*)

If you are identified as a “close contacts” and are:

- “Fully Vaccinated” and have received a booster or are not eligible for the booster
 - No restrictions on attending or working at school
 - No restrictions on extra-curricular activities
- “Fully Vaccinated” and eligible to, but have not received the booster
 - No restrictions on attending or working at school
 - Restricted from participating in extracurricular or afterschool activities for five (5) days from the exposure
- Non-Vaccinated Individuals
 - Mandatory five (5) day quarantine but eligible to participate in Test to Stay in order to attend classes
 - Restricted from participating in extracurricular or afterschool activities for five (5) days from exposure

Individuals who test positive for COVID-19 will be required to isolate for a minimum of five (5) days, regardless of vaccination status. If symptoms are resolving after five (5) days, the individual may be allowed to attend or work at school. If symptoms persist, further isolation will be required.
