Meals will be delivered to your child's **BUS STOP LOCATION** at the time of the **ELEMENTARY PICK-UP** beginning on **Wednesday morning March 18**. If you opt-in for this food delivery program, please ensure that you are waiting at the stop for the bus to arrive. We will do our best to be as timely as possible. If you do not know the time of the elementary pick-up for your location, please call the bus garage at 518-499-0808. Individuals picking up food are strongly encouraged to follow all recommended precautions while waiting, and maintain appropriate social distancing.
