Annual Asbestos Plan and Project Notifications

The Whitehall Central School District has submitted information regarding asbestos containing building materials in the school district to the New York State Education Department. This information is documented in the school district's Asbestos Management Plan, which is in accordance with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of 1987 (40 CFR Part 763). This memorandum is intended to fulfill annual notification requirements.

Under the AHERA Regulation the school district is required to perform re-inspections on all facilities which contain asbestos construction materials once every three years. The district conducted this re-inspection during the late spring of 2010. Documentation related to the re-inspection is available in the Asbestos Management Plan.

The AHERA regulations further require that asbestos containing facilities identified in the plan be surveyed every six months. These inspections have been and continue to be performed and records of the surveillances are also in the Asbestos Management Plan.

The Asbestos Management Plan for Whitehall Central School is available to the public for review during the following time period:
